

## Job Summary:

We are seeking Student Counselors to provide support and mentorship to students during a four-week science education program for students in 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade. In this position, the Student Counselors will create a positive learning and living environment for the campers by organizing and facilitating extracurricular activities, providing social and emotional support to students, and offering guidance about careers in the health sciences. They will also respond to logistical and technical issues that may arise in the dormitories. Student Counselors are expected to work in a professional setting while advocating for the needs of the students.

## Location and Dates:

*Training of counselors:* The Student Counselors will participate in a 2-day training (May 25-26) at University of Liberia College of Health Sciences (Congo Town).

*Camp implementation:* The Student Counselors will participate in the Camp, held at the Liberia Theological Baptist Seminary, July 31 – September 1, 2023. The Student Counselors will be inresidence at the Camp full-time, living in the student dormitories with students.

## Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provide mentorship to students around career and higher education options and preparation strategies, especially for the health sciences
- With the Head Counselors, design and implement enriching extracurricular activities for the students in the evenings and weekends
- Be available to students at all times for personal problems and discussions, including logistic and technical issues that may arise in the evenings at the dormitories (i.e. electricity, Wi-Fi, water, keys, cleaning issues, etc.)
- Facilitate discussions with small and large groups of students
- Maintain confidentiality and professionalism about student issues unless speaking to Camp xSEL organizers or Head Counselors
- Be present at the LBTS campus at all times during the camp
- If necessary, accompany students from and to their county as a chaperone
- Attend leadership meetings everyday at the end of classes
- Provide feedback and evaluation on aspects of the camp outside of the classroom.

# Job Requirements and Qualifications:

- Student Counselors must be a final-year student of the A.M Dogliotti College of Medicine
- Excellent interpersonal skills and passionate about mentorship and coaching
- Able to dedicate time to be on LBTS campus for the duration of the program
- Must follow all guidelines and schedules set by Camp xSEL organizers
