



# Camp Nurse

## Job Summary:

We are seeking a Camp Nurse to provide support and services during a four-week science education program for secondary school students in 11th and 12th grade. The Camp Nurse will be responsible for managing students' health. She/he will provide physical and psychological support to students. In this position, they will help and guide students with personal health problems they encounter while at the camp.

## Location and Dates:

*Training of counselors and nurses:* The Camp Nurse will participate in a 2-day training (May 25-26) at University of Liberia College of Health Sciences (Congo Town).

*Camp implementation:* The Camp Nurse will participate in the Camp, held at the Liberia Theological Baptist Seminary, July 31 – September 1, 2023. The Camp Nurse will be in-residence at the Camp full-time.

## Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Be available to students at all times for personal problems and discussions
- Be available to respond to health issues of students outside of the classroom; this may include:
  - Conducting ongoing assessments as determined by student's condition based on best practices, procedures or protocols and reprioritize care accordingly
  - Develop plan of care that is individualized for a student
  - Perform therapeutic nursing interventions as established by individualized plan of care for the student, in a non-judgmental, non-discriminatory manner that is sensitive to the students
  - Provide student education customized to students
  - For more serious health conditions, initiate referral to appropriate health facility
  - Initiate emergency contact in case of emergency
  - Reports student condition to Camp xSEL management team
- Design health education workshops to promote lifelong health and wellness, including education on sexual and reproductive health, and other priority topics
- Maintain confidentiality and professionalism about students' problems unless speaking to Camp xSEL organizers
- Be present at the LBTS campus at all times during the camp
- Attend Leadership meetings every day at the end of classes
- Provide feedback and evaluation on aspects of the camp outside of the classroom

## Job Requirements and Qualifications:

- Graduate of an accredited school of nursing, is licensed and is in good standing with the Liberia Board of Nursing & Midwifery
- Evidence of 5 years of nursing experience
- Clinicians with mental health training and/or adolescent health will be given preference
- Training in child protection, leadership, and mental health care preferred
- Have experience facilitating interactive workshops
- Able to dedicate time to be on campus throughout the duration of the program
- Must follow all guidelines and schedules set by Camp xSEL organizers
